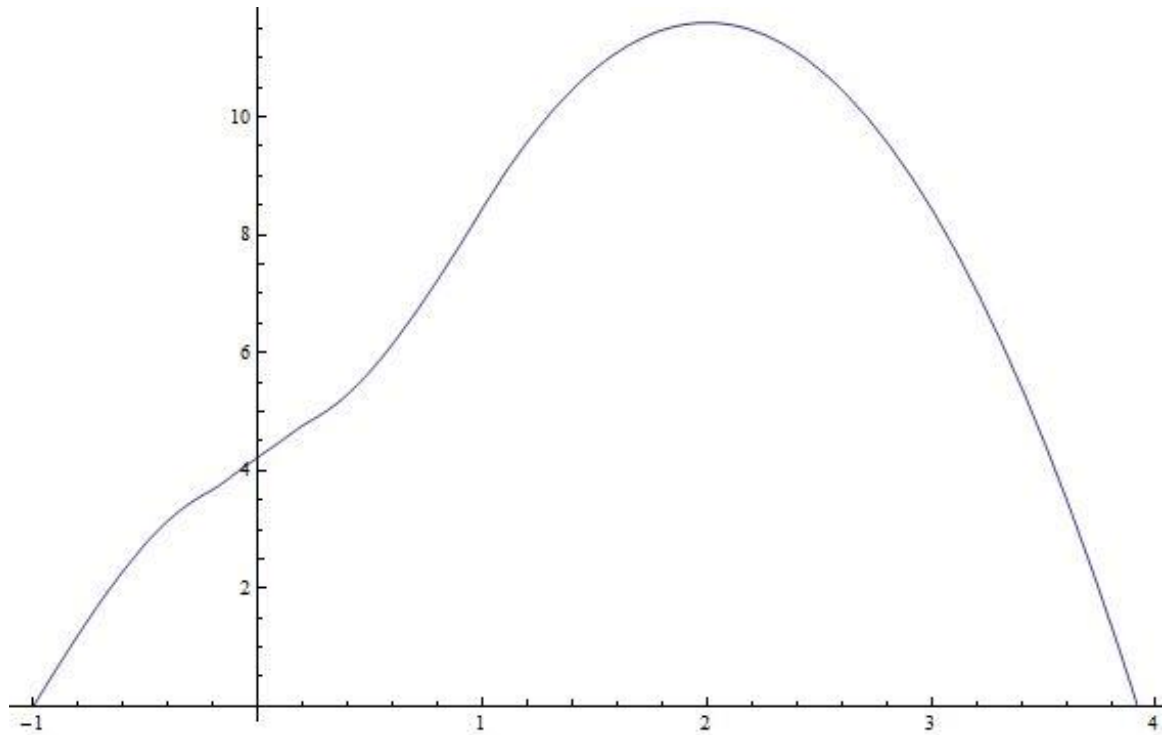


Figure 1: **Temp diagram holder**
